Be Understanding of the vision of Riverside Community Church and only do things that fall in line with their vision

EXPECTATIONS OF TEAM MEMBERS:

I realize that being part of this team is a responsibility as well as a privilege. I realize that i will be expected to:

- Be committed to the team
- Have a positive attitude in all circumstances- even when plans change
- Be respectful and obey the direction of my team leader(s) and the Israelis we work with
- Leave my “American” way of thinking behind, and try to see Israel through an Israelis perspective
- To take part in learning about the Israeli culture and to strive to be culturally sensitive to my host culture at all times
- complete all tasks and studies as directed by the leadership of this team

TEAM MEMBERS COMMITMENT

Please read and initial the following:

_____I acknowledge that I will be in a different culture where some common USA behaviors or customs may not apply or even be offensive to the Israelis or missionaries, therefore I will take care to be aware of my behavior and how it affects those around me.

_____I commit to being flexible, patient and pleasant. I will, at all times, exemplify strong morals and positive behavior in order to be a role model and influence to those around me.

_____I commit to only take actions that fall in line with Riverside’s mission and vision

_____I acknowledge that I am a guest working with the different Israeli ministries and will behave and respond as a grateful visitor, including eating what I’m offered and participating with community activities as they are presented.

_____ I understand that I am here to serve and that I will be respectful and honoring to the people, my team, and culture in which i am serving.

_____ I will remember I have come to learn as well as to teach. I'll resist the temptation to inform our hosts about "how we do things." I will be open to learning about other people's methods & ideas, in all areas of work, leisure and religion.

_____ I will develop & maintain a servant attitude toward all nationals, Ministries staff, teachers, clinic workers, onsite missionaries, team members and team leaders.

_____ I commit to respect and submit to all ministry staff along with my team leaders and his or her decisions.

_____ I will refrain from complaining. I know that travel can present numerous unexpected and undesired circumstances, but the rewards of conquering such circumstances are innumerable. Instead of whining and complaining, I'll be creative and supportive.

_____ I understand that I am going to Israel as a team member of Riverside Community Church. I will participate in all trainings and group activities before, during and after my time in Israel.

_____ I will abstain from illegal drugs, tobacco and alcohol abuse, as well as offensive and immodest dress and profanity during this mission.

_____ I will only make phone calls, text, email, use social media during designated times by my Team Leader. I understand that it can be a distraction and I will not allow it to interfere with team time or the community we are serving alongside.
